- Rules and Conditions: All participants must obey the rules of the Camdeboo Eisteddfod.

Entries:

- Closing date for ALL CATEGORIES: 15 July 2024.
- When an age limit is specified, the competitor must not have exceeded the said age on 1 January.
- NO PARTICIPANTS MAY BE REPLACED AFTER THE OFFICIAL CLOSING DATE.
- Only one entry per competitor is allowed per category item.
- Cancellations must be reported to the appropriate convenor at least 24 hours before the performance.
- The name on the entry form is the name that will appear on the certificate. Please make sure of the correct spelling! R25 per correction (eg. John Smith, not in capital letters)

Entry Fees:

- Solo / Individual (All categories) R50

Groups (Music and Dance)

- R120.00 per duet entry.
- R180.00 per trio entry.
- R240.00 per quartet entry.
- R280.00 per ensemble entry (5 – 8).
- R300.00 per ensemble entry (9 – 20).
- R450.00 per choir or orchestra.

Groups (Drama)

- R120.00 per dialogue.
- R120.00 per extract from play/prose.
- R160.00 per concert program (group).
- R160.00 per mime (group).
- R160.00 per choral verse (4-12 members).
- R180.00 per choral verse (13 – 30+members).

Participation:

- The same item may not be performed by the same participant in more than one subsection of a category.
- Participants must report to the venue 15 minutes before the starting time.
- Each entry receives a participant's slip which must be handed in at the time of adjudication.
- Where participants perform own choice works, an identical copy must be presented to the adjudicators.

Adjudication:

- Results are final and may not be negotiated with adjudicators or convenors.
- No participants, coaches or parents are allowed to confer with the adjudicators until after the adjudication.

Awards/Certificates:

90% and higher = Cum Laude

85% – 89% = Gold Plus

80% – 84% = Gold

75% – 79% = Silver Plus

70% – 74% = Silver

60% – 69% = Bronze

50% – 59% = Certificate of participation

* Certificates will be issued according to the spelling on the entry forms.

To be considered for a Prize-winner certificate, a participant should partake in at least 2 items.
